

Buckhorn Weston and Kington Magna Neighbourhood Plan Submission Consultation

Buckhorn Weston and Kington Magna Parish Council has submitted a draft **neighbourhood plan**.¹ The plan includes planning policies to protect and enhance the character of Buckhorn Weston and Kington Magna. These policies are intended to help make decisions on planning applications in the two parishes.

The public now have 6 weeks (between 10 November and 22 December 2023) to comment on the draft plan.² The draft plan and the comments received to the consultation will be sent to an independent examiner for consideration.
