

Hazelbury Bryan Neighbourhood Plan – First Review

Submission Consultation

Hazelbury Bryan Parish Council has undertaken a review of its neighbourhood plan and submitted the revised plan for examination.¹ The plan includes planning policies to protect and enhance the character of Hazelbury Bryan. These policies are intended to help make decisions on planning applications in the parish.

Before the examination, the public have an opportunity to comment on the draft plan.² The consultation period is from 24 November 2023 to 12 January 2024. The draft plan and the comments received to the consultation will be considered by an independent examiner.
